

John Lemm – Director, Intalok NZ

John joined Intalok in Tauranga in 1985, where he worked for nine years as a construction supervisor, before a stint of spec building. Returning to Intalok in 1999 as production manager for the company's overseas projects – including a large contract in the Maldives, and then supplying pre cut fabricated flooring and walls for 104 bures to a \$20 million hotel resort project in Tahiti.

In 2004 John and his wife Jude purchased the Intalok Company 50/50 with Catherine and Barry Cawte, and with their current focus on growing the domestic market, are now building up to 25 natural timber Intalok homes a year and supplying interior wall product to Sunshine Homes for more than another 200 homes.

Intalok employs 30 full-time staff, up to 10 Tauranga builders, and 12 more around the country as builder agents for Intalok natural timber homes.

John is a member of the Tauranga Chamber of Commerce, The President (Elected 2009) of the Pine Manufacturers Association Executive Council and is active in the Tauranga Game Fishing Club.
